### RWANDA EXPANDS COFFEE MARKET TO PAKISTAN

Rwanda is targeting Pakistan's growing coffee market following a two-day exhibition in Islamabad. In 2025, Rwanda exported **23,860 metric tons of coffee**, generating over **216 billion RWF**, signaling continued export growth.

### CENTRAL BANK RAISES KEY INTEREST RATE

The National Bank of Rwanda increased its key interest rate by 50 basis points (0.5%) to contain inflation and maintain macroeconomic stability, reinforcing investor confidence.

## LOGISTICS AMBITION TAKES SHAPE

Rwanda's national logistics operator MAGERWA has been acquired by Africa Global Logistics, backed by MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company, strengthening Rwanda's role as a regional logistics hub.

### DRONE & AI LOGISTICS EXPANSION

Rwanda signed an expansion agreement with Zipline, supported by \$150M U.S. funding, to scale autonomous drone delivery nationwide — including urban rollout in Kigali and a new hub in Karongi District.

With over 400,000 farmers depending on coffee, Rwanda is strengthening traceability and sustainability standards to meet evolving European regulations and secure long-term competitiveness.
